### Results

Everyone's hard work during this academic year has paid off and results across the school are very good indeed and are above national figures. The results below show percentages of pupils who have reached the expected standard.

EYFS – 81%

Year 1 Phonics – 90%

KS1 Reading – 82%

KS1 Writing – 71%

KS1 Maths – 82%

KS2 Reading – 90%

KS2 Writing – 90%

KS2 Grammar, Punctuation & Spelling – 90%

KS2 Maths – 85%
