

## English

We will be studying several different genres this term in literacy, including:

- Biographies and autobiographies
- Poetry
- Guides to Hogwarts
- Descriptive writing
- and a variety of way to make our writing more interesting, including using: a range of parenthesis, figurative language, and dashes for a variety of purposes.

## French

We will be studying clothes and professions this term.

## Computing

We will be starting to learn how to code on Scratch this term, culminating in making animations and a small game.

## RE

We will be looking at Islam this term in R.E. and will study its customs and beliefs. We will also be comparing it to other monotheistic religions and looking for similarities.

## Music

The children will be learning their songs for the Christmas production, as well as creating their own pieces of music using percussive and melodic accompaniments.

## Art, Design & Technology

The children will be creating Egyptian portraits using oil and chalk pastels this term.

The children will be studying gymnastics and dance this term.

## Mathematics

We will be building on the concepts studied last term in maths and expanding them to cover a range of topics, including:

- Using brackets and looking at calculation order
- Calculating a percentage and a fraction of an amount.
- Converting measurements between imperial and metric.
- Using 4 quadrant grids
