

English

Report Writing - All About Me. The children will analyse report texts, noting their function, form and typical language features. They will then write their own report.

Stories by the Same Author - Using the delightful illustrations and books of Michael Foreman, children will have many opportunities to practice simple, compound and complex sentences with powerful verbs. They then create their own stories based around **I'll Take You to Mrs Cole**, by Nigel Gray and Michael Foreman.

Recount – Cross curricular with our trip to Swindon Steam Museum, writing a recount of their experience as an evacuee.



Science

The children will discover fascinating facts about the Sun. Explore the Earth's movement to give seasons and day and night. Investigate shadows and sundials. Discuss safety in the Sun and solar energy. Children also find out about transparent, opaque and translucent materials.

Music

Animal Magic: This term the children will learn how to recognise how musical elements are used and combined to describe different animals. They will be introduced to recorders.

Art, Design & Technology

Children will use a variety of materials to produce 3-d friendship pictures. The children will use pastels to create a blitz skyline and design and make Bomb Shelters.



P.E.

Monday and Friday sessions will be based around ball skill invasion games such as rugby, hockey and bench-ball.



Mathematics

Children will practise their mental maths skills weekly, through Maths Clubs, Doubles and Mental Maths tests, to build up their speed in answering questions. They will also be learning multiplication tables up to 12 x12 over the year.

Sessions this term will include:

- Place value.
- Addition and subtraction.
- Shape, measure and data.
- Multiplication and division.
- Number, place value and money.

Computing

Children will continue to use IT to support other curriculum areas as well as being introduced to graphics programmes.

History/Geography

World War II
