Science

Amazing Magnets

Children will be comparing how things move on different surfaces. Observe how magnets attract and repel each other. Compare and group everyday materials based on whether they are attracted to a magnet or not.

Music

Play it again
Children will create and perform simple rhythmic patterns. They will be introduced to the recorder and continue developing their singing voice.

Art, Design & Technology

Children will use a variety of materials to produce 3-d friendship pictures. The children will use pastels to create a blitz skyline and design and make Bomb Shelters.

P.E.

Monday sessions with Mr Lester will be Gymnastics. Fridays sessions – Fundamentals of Movement, Agility, Balance and Co-ordination.

Mathematics

Children will practise their mental maths skills weekly, through Maths Clubs, Doubles and Mental Maths tests, to build up their speed in answering questions. They will also be learning multiplication tables up to 12 x12 over the year.

- Shape, measure and data.
- Multiplication and division.
- Number, place value and money.
