

English

- We encourage the children to read at least 5 times a week at home and ask that they or parents record this in their reading diaries. Children will take part in Guided Reading sessions where they will develop their comprehension skills.
- The children will be learning how to write instructions to make a healthy snack for someone else to follow and make.
- They will be writing and performing plays.



Music

•This term we will continue with recorder sessions on Tuesday mornings, further developing children's ability to read music and understand tempo and rhythm.



Art, Design & Technology

Mod Rock Models - children will design and make models based on river creatures, from a variety of materials, which they will cover with mod-rock and paint.



P.E and Games

On Monday Mr Lester will be taking the children for Gym. They will be carrying out balances and stretches on the apparatus. Friday sessions will be Dance with Mrs Campbell.



Mathematics

Children will practise their mental maths skills weekly, through Maths Clubs, Doubles and Mental Maths tests, to build up their speed in answering questions.

Sessions this term will include:

- Place value
- Using addition and subtraction facts
- Adding 2 and 3 -digit numbers.
- Subtraction strategies: bridging the tens, place value and number facts.
- Weight - kilograms and grams.
- Handling data – linked to weight.
- Reasoning and explaining.

Science

Helping Plants Grow

The children will be studying the parts of flowering plants and their functions, the conditions affecting plant growth and plants as living things. They will investigate how water is transported in plants. Describe plant life cycles, in particular how seeds are formed, dispersed and germinate.



Computing

The children will continue to develop their keyboard skills and will use the internet for research. They will also use IT to select, record and organise sounds .

PSHE

Say No To Bullying. Children will learn that their actions affect themselves and others. They will think about the feelings and viewpoints of other people.

History/Geography Rivers

Children will learn about the formation and features of a river, how they were formed and the different features of a river. They will follow a rivers journey to the sea and discover the role of the water cycle. They will learn about the 10 major world rivers.
