

## English

This term we will be looking at a variety of genres in literacy, the three main areas being:

- Mystery stories
- Fantasy stories
- Poetry

We will also cover a variety of punctuation, spelling and grammar rules in preparation for the GPS test and to add extra sparkle and variety to our writing.

## French

In this term we will be looking at clothes and the classroom.

## RE

We will analyse and compare how different religions worship their God/s this term. Focusing primarily on Christianity and Islam, but also looking at Hinduism, Judaism and Buddhism as well.

## Music

We will be exploring sound sources in terms 3 & 4. This includes:

- Identifying different textures of un-tuned sounds
- Creating different sound effects

## Computing

We will be creating our own games on an online program called Scratch.

## PSHE

This term we will be looking at setting goals and at change in order to prepare the children for secondary school.

## Art, Design & Technology

This term the class will be designing and producing their own product packaging.

## P.E.

In P.E. this term, we will continue studying the Real P.E. curriculum as well as dance.

## Mathematics

We will be covering a number of key mathematical concepts this term in order to consolidate our understanding and extend our abilities. Areas covered will include:

- Ratio and proportion
- Converting between metric and imperial units
- Converting between different metric units
- Trial and error problems
- Word problems involving all 4 formal written calculations
- Converting between fraction, decimals and percentages

## History/Geography

We begin a new topic this term and will be learning all about Mountains. We shall particularly focus on:

- The features of mountains
- How mountains are formed
- Famous Mountains
- Mountain Environments

## Science

The children will be learning about micro-organisms this term. We will study the three main types of micro-organism and create our own disease. We will investigate which conditions are best for mould to grow in and how micro-organisms impact on our day-to-day lives.
