

## English

After the SAT exams, we will be writing balanced arguments and newspaper articles.

## P.E.

The children will continue to study the Real P.E. programme this term as well as invasion games.

## Mathematics

We will mostly focus on revising the year 6 curriculum this term and so will be covering a wide range of subjects, including:

- Fractions
- Shape and space
- Applying a wide range of mathematical knowledge to solve reasoning problems
- Area and perimeter
- Angles and measurements

## French

We are going to be studying how to describe different rooms in a house and then move onto vacation vocabulary and phrases.

## Computing

The children will be creating their own interactive adventure game books this term.

## RE

We will be studying and comparing different religious buildings.

## PSHE

During this term, we will be looking at how to build and maintain positive relationships.

## Science

During this term, we will be studying how The Earth was formed and then move on to studying the different time periods that lead to the evolution of mankind.

## History/Geography

We start a new topic this term, Contrasting Localities. In this topic we look at both the geography and history of Charlbury, Oxford and Tokyo. We compare their: economy, history, people, architecture, society and natural features and develop an understanding of what they have in common and how they differ.
